QUESTION	ANSWER
<p><b>1. Can International organizations apply for this call?</b></p>	<p>On Page 7 of the Call for Proposals document, under <b>2.1.1 Admissibility of Applicants</b>, to be admissible for grants, the applicant must satisfy all the following conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. be a legal person; and</li><li>2. be a non-profit private entity or a foundation; and</li><li>3. <b>be established in Palestine;</b> and</li><li>4. be directly responsible for the preparation and management of the action with the co-applicant(s) and not be acting as an intermediary; and</li><li>5. have an active bank account for the past 24 months; and</li><li>6. have audited financial statements (income statement and balance sheet) of the last closed financial year.</li></ol> <p>For point # 3, establishment is determined on the basis of the organisation’s articles of association, which must show that the organisation was created by an act of law of the country in question and that its registered office is situated in an eligible country. In this respect, any legal entities whose articles of association were created in another country may not be considered to be an eligible local organisation, even where registered locally or where a “memorandum of understanding” has been entered into. <b>Therefore, international NGOs that were not established in Palestine by the Palestinian Law cannot apply to this call for Proposals even if they are currently represented in Palestine.</b></p> <p><i>Please refer to <b>2.1.1 Admissibility of applicants: page 7</b></i></p>
<p><b>2. Can a co-applicant be an INGO?</b></p>	<p>This CfP is only targeting national NGOs established, registered, and working in Palestine.</p> <p><i>Please refer to <b>2.1.1 Admissibility of applicants: page 7</b></i></p>

<p><b>3. Can private profit companies apply?</b></p>	<p>Please refer to <b>2.1.1. Admissibility of applicants</b> on page 7 of the call.  To be admissible for grants, the applicant must satisfy all the following conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. be a legal person; and</li> <li>2. <b>be a non-profit private entity or a foundation;</b> and</li> <li>3. be established in Palestine; and</li> <li>4. be directly responsible for the preparation and management of the action with the co-applicant(s) and not be acting as an intermediary; and</li> <li>5. have an active bank account for the past 24 months; and</li> <li>6. have audited financial statements (income statement and balance sheet) of the last closed financial year</li> </ol> <p><b>Any applicant should be a non-profit private entity or foundation.</b>  <i>Please refer to <b>2.1.1 Admissibility of applicants: page 7</b></i></p>
<p><b>4. Can an organization apply to two Calls for proposals at the same time?</b></p>	<p>Yes, organisations can apply to other Calls for Proposals posted by Enabel, if eligible.</p>
<p><b>5. Can an individual consultant or freelancer apply for the call?</b></p>	<p>No, it is not possible.</p> <p><i>Please refer to <b>2.1.1 Admissibility of applicants: page 7</b></i></p>
<p><b>6. If the NGO is working only in Gaza, can its activities be implemented only in Gaza?</b></p>	<p>The CfP is covering all areas in Palestine including Gaza, West Bank and East Jerusalem. Therefore, the main applicant together with the co-applicants should cover all geographic areas through one application.  <i>Please refer to <b>Geographical coverage: page 9</b></i></p>
<p><b>7. Can co- applicants be from different areas?</b></p>	<p>Applicants are encouraged to choose co-applicants to cover all areas in this call for proposals, therefore it's encouraged that they are located in different areas.  <i>Please refer to <b>Geographical coverage: page 9</b></i></p>
<p><b>8. What kind of organisations can apply?</b></p>	<p><i>Please refer to <b>2.1.1 Admissibility of applicants: page 7</b></i></p>
<p><b>9. If the applicant is representing an International NGO, can it apply?</b></p>	<p>Applicants should be established in Palestine. Establishment is determined on the basis of the organisation's articles of association, which must show that the organisation was created by an act of law of the country in question and that its registered office is situated in an eligible country. In this respect, any legal entities whose articles of association were created in another country may not be considered to be an eligible local organisation, even where registered locally or where a "memorandum of understanding" has been entered into.</p>

	<p>Therefore, any organization that was not established by the Palestinian Law is ineligible.</p> <p><i>Please refer to 2.1.1 Admissibility of applicants: page 7</i></p>
<b>10. Does the fund cover both organisations?</b>	The total amount of the call for proposals, should cover all activities, for the main applicant as well as the co-applicant(s).
<b>11. Can an NGO apply if they are established in north/west Jerusalem?</b>	<p>Yes they can if they meet with all conditions of admissibility.</p> <p><i>Please refer to 2.1.1 Admissibility of applicants: page 7</i></p>
<b>12. If the concept note is for 24 months, does this affect the evaluation?</b>	<p>This is a three-year campaign; therefore, the proposal should consider this timeframe.</p> <p><i>Please refer to page 5 of the Call.</i></p>
<b>13. In case an organization has been granted an award to implement a project with ENABEL, is it still eligible to apply for ongoing proposals?</b>	NGOs currently in partnership with Enabel can still apply if they meet the admissibility conditions of this specific Call.
<b>14. Can the presentation be shared with the participants?</b>	All information in the presentation available in the published guidelines of the Call.
